Back-to-School is fast in its approach! Please make sure to be very involved in your child's education the first two weeks back at school. What does "involved" mean?

- For our elementary families: Please take at least one morning off to go observe your child's classroom. Make sure the school year is off to a great start by introducing yourself to your child's teacher, and making sure the child-teacher match is beginning positively. Talk to your child's teacher or school principal or us if you have concerns.
- For our middle and high school families: Please make sure your child is enrolled in the right classes. Sometimes this can be a confusing process, so please call us immediately if you have any concerns. I am always mostly concerned with what math level students are being programmed in, so be very aware. Counselors are only human—mistakes can be made.
- Please set up a consistent homework routine right away! Do not take the answer: "I have no homework." The more you are on top of schoolwork in the fall—the better your spring will be.
